Government has reinstated the SRD Grant till March 2022!

Pick n Pay
— and —
BOXER



Are you an approved SRD R350 Grant beneficiary?
Watch closely.

Where do I access my grant once I've been approved?



However, you can only go to **Pick n Pay or Boxer** once you have received the SMS telling you to do so.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION
Always have your cellphone and ID number with you. A USSD will be sent to your mobile phone when you are at the till, to approve the cash withdrawal.



Do I need a bank account?



Moenie worry nie. A Postbank Account can be opened on 'your' behalf if needed.



Don't have a bank account? S'kastressa! You will by default qualify for Postbank's Electronic Disbursement Solution.



But what's an Electronic Disbursement Solution? "It is a digital solution enabling you to transact without a card where your ID and your unique cell phone number replaces the need for a card."

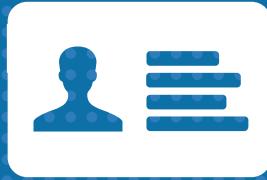


...Instead of an actual bank card, it can be linked to your ID number and cellphone. Whether you have a smartphone or not, it works. You can transact!
